

Nomination Petition Information For Bi-Annual Town of Morrison

December 20, 2021

The bi-annual election will be Tuesday April 5, 2022. There are four (4) Town Trustee positions and the Mayor up for election.

Petitions for Town Trustee and Mayor positions will be available and may be circulated for the first time on Monday, January 3, 2022. Persons interested in running for office can pick up nomination petitions from the Town Clerk at 321 Highway 8, Morrison, Colorado, 80465. The signed petitions must be returned to the Town Clerk's office by 4:30 p.m., Friday, January 24, 2022.

The petitions need a minimum of 10 signatures. Each signer must be a registered elector residing within the Town limits. No registered elector shall sign more than one nomination petition for each position to be filled. The 2022 Town election ballot will list the four (4) Trustee positions; three of which are four (4) year terms and one of which is a two (2) year term. The candidate receiving the fourth most number of votes will be appointed to the two (2) year term position. The 2022 Town Election ballot will list one (1) Mayor position, of which is a four (4) year term.

To run for a Board of Trustees or Mayor position you must be a registered elector, 21 years of age or older on the date of election (April 5, 2022), and have resided in the Town of Morrison for a period of at least twelve (12) consecutive months immediately preceding the date of the election.

Persons desiring to vote in the upcoming election who have not registered to vote, must do so by Monday, March 14, 2022.
