What's Happening

FROM THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Hogback Notes November 2019

The Town of Morrison recently bought a parcel of land within the Town boundary. The property is on the south side of Highway 74 at the west end of Town across from the Red Rocks Chapel/ Running Store and is highlighted in Green on the map/image below (Parcel ID 40-353-05-001). We purchased the property for \$415,000. Part of the transaction involved 'cleaning up' some property boundaries and Right of Way vacations that resulted in the separation of 802 Bear Creek Lane and 804 Bear Creek lane into two separate properties. All of these activities took place in public meetings of the Planning Commission and the Board of Trustees. The Town's acquisition of this property serves two purposes: 1) It diversifies our capital assets away from just financial deposits that earn very low returns (~2% per year), and 2) Acquisition of this particular property gives the people of Morrison significant control over the development and appearance of the 'back door' entrance to our town from Highway 74 on the west. We look forward to suggestions from Town residents as to what the most appropriate use of this property is. Some possibilities include the following: 1) Using it as a location for a new Town Office and Court which we need to build in order to meet the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) legal requirements, 2) Using it to expand the town park. If we use it to expand the Town park we may build a small stage/amphitheater for events such as the Cider Fest and/or any other public celebrations/events (Paul Sutton hopes for outdoor Shakespeare performances). We welcome suggestions from the community. We are in no hurry to do anything with the property at this time but we are very happy to have secured control over a previously undeveloped property at one of the gateways to our town.

Morrison Museum will be **closed on Thanksgiving day**. We will reopen the following day on our normal schedule.


Black Friday Special: purchase \$30 from the gift shop and receive three free general admission tickets to tour the museum with a guide.



Caroling in Morrison




Friday, December 6, 2019 6:00 P.M.
