What the Board Has Been Up To:

Just like residents and businesses alike, the Board has been responding to the uncertainties of COVID these last few months, assessing and reassessing the Town and Board operations. For the time being, the Board will continue to hold their Regular meetings via Zoom and welcome and encourage residents to participate virtually, as the Town Hall is closed to the public.

Since the June 2, 2020 meeting, the Board has reviewed and adopted ordinances: 493-Amending Morrison Municipal Code Penalties; 494- Enacting Temporary Special Use Permits; 495- Amending Definition of Substantial Improvement to be consistent with Urban Drainage; and, 496- Granting Franchise Agreement to Xcel Energy. Per charter, Ordinances are published by title in the Canyon Courier and available in full on the Town Website.

On June 16, 2020 the Board appointed Honorable David Thrower as the new Morrison Municipal Court Judge. Thrower presides over municipal court with years of experience working in other comparable municipal courts such as Superior, Nederland, and Mead, CO.

At the June 16, 2020 Board Meeting, the Board approved the purchase and use of Body Cameras for on- duty Morrison Police Officers. This approval is in compliance with SB 217.

The Board has also been discussing and evaluating the consistent noise nuisances that seem to cover the Town in the summer months. The Board has directed Staff to research and prepare a proposal for a noise study, update local signs to notify drivers of noise ordinance restrictions, and asked the police to purchase a decibel meter and increase enforcement of the noise ordinance.

Budget season is just around the corner. The Board will take the opportunity the upcoming months to review and evaluate the proposed 2021 Budget with final Budget Adoption scheduled for November.

The Board of Trustees meets every first and third Tuesday of the month. If you have any questions, comments, or concerns, please feel free to virtually attend an upcoming Board Meeting.

- Don't have a smart device? You may borrow a tablet with the MNHM tour app preloaded.


